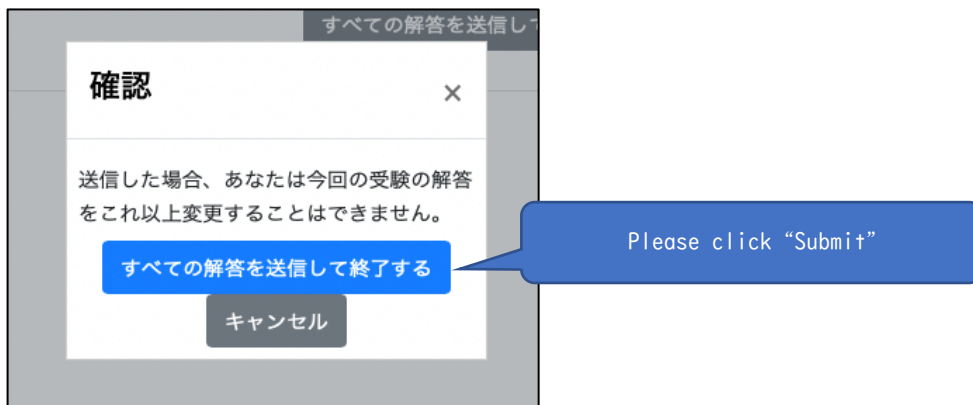

Based on your test answers, we can provide you with information about which skills you have mastered and which skills require improvement. The orange line on the chart below shows the average skill mastery profile of students who have taken the test. Skill 1 through skill 7 represent the seven key skills required for listening (see the detailed descriptions of each skill in the listening section). There are some exercises prepared for Rank B and C to practice and improve listening skills. If you got all skill performance in Rank A, try some more challenging exercises.

Descriptions of 7 capabilities of listening

Skill	Description
1. Syntactic understanding	The ability to use grammar knowledge to understand what the speaker is saying
2. Understanding main idea	The ability to distinguish between sounds and intonations and understand what the speaker is saying
3. Understanding specific information	The ability to understand the important points of a conversation based on the overall contents of the subjects discussed
4. Understanding complex information	The ability to listen for and to identify vital individual pieces of information
5. Understanding usage domains	The ability to listen for and to identify multiple pieces of information and to gain an overall understanding on them
6. Usage domains	The ability to understand distinct expressions and/or manners of speaking that are unique to certain occupations, etc.
7. Understanding complex information	The ability to make deductions on the meanings of unfamiliar words and expressions

Results of 7 capabilities

1. Syntactic understanding

Rank: B

It seems that you occasionally have difficulties with grammar, specifically with giving and receiving expressions (yari-morai) and verb forms. Understanding this kind of grammar will help you better understand what the speaker is saying. We suggest you pay closer attention to the grammar when listening.
